

# "Art No Stop Network" Constitution

# 1.Art No Stop Network

- The following document is the Constitution of the "Art No Stop Network".
- All bodies and individuals coming under the "Art No Stop Network" must adhere to the Constitution.
- Further documents may be designated as foundational documents to the "Art No Stop Network" by the Funders Organizations Legal Representatives
- "Art No Stop Network" is also known as 'AnSn' and these terms can be used interchangeably.

# 2. Aims of AnSn

- The general objective of the Art No Stop Network is to promote the creation of a network which incentivizes inclusion and creative education accessible to social projects and artists
- "Art No Stop Network" is a community of social workers, artists, creative professionals and institutions committed to building a solid bridge between the world of Art and those organizations working in the social field
- Providing support for artists working in the field of social practice offering services developed in social spaces
- Experiment with new models of ACTIVE WELCOMING within the communities, which provide permanent education for adults using creative residencies and art exhibitions inside and outside the host communities.
- Generate and empower the digital web platform <u>www.artnostop.com</u> which brings together social projects capable of providing training and services beneficial to artists.
- Train permanently social workers with the necessary artistic/technical/digital skills to manage their social projects as places of Active Reception, promoting artistic residencies and events
- Train permanently vulnerable adults and low-skilled project clients and in the technical production of art shows in order to bring them closer to the art world and give them greater job opportunities
- Make the condition of vulnerable people visible through art and educate citizens in order to change their perspective towards migrants.
- Offer vulnerable adults a different perspective of host communities where the user is the protagonist and engine of their community together with the technical team
- Promote the inclusion of art as a form of informal education thanks to the consolidation of its presence and support in social projects
- Sustain the vision of communities as a social entrepreneurship project in favor of the principle of Generative Welfare.



#### 3. Activities of AnSn

- Offer and organization of artistic residencies.
- Promoting participation in the activities of other organizations
- Promote cooperation networks for future projects
- Disseminate the projects of the members of the network
- Disseminate external initiatives of interest to the network
- To support the organization of artistic residencies of the network
- Search for new artists
- Search for new organizations
- Facilitate dialogue between organizations
- Offer examples of good practices and successful projects.
- Disseminate call for social art
- Promoting the network
- To support the search for external participants for the projects of the network's organizations
- Search for host communities and social projects where artistic residencies can be offered.
- Organize talks in the local environments of each organization for the dissemination of the network and the work.





# 4. Composition

- Social Art Network is composed of the following bodies:
  - i. Fundación Escuela de Solidaridad Granada (ES)
  - ii. Coop. Soc. TenRock Brindisi (IT)
  - iii. diekunstBaustelle Ladnsberg (D)
  - iv. Changes & Chances 's Hertogenbosch (NL)
  - v.B-Brave Lecce (IT)

### 5.Members

To be Member of the "Art No Stop Network", an organization/artist/... need to apply through the web site www.artnostop.com/network.

- The selection of the new members is chosen but the members with at least 1 year of activity in the "Art No Stop Network".
- To approve a new member it needs at least % of the votes.
- Members are active participants of the "Art No Stop Network" and have to participate at least to one meeting every year and be active in one Creative Residency every year.





#### 6.Coordinators

- Coordinators are responsible for either:
  - i. Organizing and representing a group.
- Each group will have a coordinator(s)
  - ii. The coordinator(s) will typically be one to two persons.
  - iii. The coordinator(s) represent their working group during: Annual General Meeting and Trimester International on-line Meeting.
- Coordinators role ends with:
  - iv.On an annual basis, each group elects its own coordinator with its own internal system.
  - v. The new coordinator(s) is officially introduced during the meeting.
  - vi. The coordinator can voluntarily leave his role and the group will be in charge of his replacement.
  - vii. The group can request the replacement of a coordinator before the end of his year of charge.





# 7. Meetings and Meetups

## 7.1. Annual General Meeting (AGM)

- The AGM is the meeting of all AnSn members.
- During the AGM, the members of the AnSn Coordinating Committee will be elected.
- The AGM will be held in Granada:
  - i.Meeting annually.
  - ii.The AGM will be held in person
- iii.The coordinators of each group will receive an invitation to attend the AGM.

# 7.2. Trimester international on-line meeting

- The Trimester international on-line meeting is a meeting of all AnSn members.
- The Trimester international on-line meeting will be held online:
- i.More than one member of each group can attend the meeting
- ii.The coordinator of each group has to attend the meeting
- iii.Receiving reports from all members, sharing their work and discussing the future work.
  - iv. Supporting and developing the work in neetwork.



- The Committee will be composed of 3 members in which one is always one of the founders
- The members of the Committee will be elected with the ¾ of the votes.
  - i. Terms will last minimum for 1 year (12 months), rounded up or down within a month.
  - ii. Where vacancies emerge outside of the annual elections, elections can be held via Assembly, to serve out the rest of the term of the position.
  - iii. New committee members are elected annually at the AGM.
  - iv. Rotation among the different AnSn members is guaranteed.
- The Committee is responsible for:
  - v. Running the day-to-day coordination of the AnSn.
  - vi. Liaising with and offering support to the members of AnSn..
  - vii. Officializing decisions on behalf of the AnSn.
